

ALL CLEAR NOTICE – DRINKING WATER WARNING LIFTED

Park Water Company is pleased to inform customers that the previous Drinking Water Warning regarding elevated nitrate levels has been changed. Follow-up testing has confirmed that nitrate levels in the water supply are now below the maximum contaminant level (MCL) of 10 mg/L established by drinking water safety standards.

It is now safe to use the water for all purposes, including for infants under 6 months old and for preparing infant formula.

The earlier notice, issued on 4/28/2026, advised customers not to give tap water to infants under 6 months of age or use it to make infant formula due to nitrate levels of 33 mg/L. Secondary confirmation samples from 4/29/2026 and continued monitoring have verified that the water system is now in compliance and the restriction has been lifted.

What should I do now?

- You may resume normal use of tap water for drinking, cooking, and preparing infant formula.
- No special actions such as flushing pipes or boiling water are necessary.
- Park Water Company will continue routine monitoring to ensure water quality remains safe.

What was done?

The water system collected confirmation samples, investigated the source of the nitrate levels. System will continue to work with ADEQ to investigate the cause of the elevated sample results.
