On October 13, 2023, I sent out an email to Southwestern Utility Management to suspend any additional taps in the **main distribution line**. There are 60 plus service lines at the present time, which is putting the well close to capacity. Any additional taps or extension will require approval from the Wild Flower Water Co-op Board. An engineering grant is in progress to evaluate the well capacity and what is needed to upgrade the well to support our needs. Note: this grant is at no cost to the members.

We would like to inform Southwestern Utility Management, Wild Flower Water Co-op Members, and individuals or entity that all letters that were generated by the prior Wild Flower Co-op Board under David Carr are still valid. Notably, the email generated October 13,2023 and the notification letter to Wild Flower Water Co-op members dated November 7,2023.

These notifications stated that any additional line taps in the main distribution lines have been suspended. The current well is at capacity and cannot handle any more members. A second well is needed for more taps.

At the present time we have 70 valid connections. Currently, sixty-four are in service.

The president of Wild Flower Water Co-op must be notified when a new account is established, requests for taps, and Blue stake.
